The Foundation is **not** closing its operations.

The Foundation is closing its registry for both Pure Spanish Horses and Half Spanish Horses.

Our primary mission has always been to serve the best interests of the P.R.E. Thus, with the improvements in the speed of service from the Spanish Stud Book, and with today's new technology, there is no longer a need for two P.R.E. registries.

Through our negotiations with ANCCE, we are able to offer entrance to the eligible P.R.E. horses of our Carta Mundial. Horses that meet the qualifications below can be inscribed and revised in one service for inclusion in the Spanish Stud Book.

Our efforts for the next several months will be devoted to arranging visits for the ANCCE inspector to see as many horses as desire to participate. By the end of this year, look for a bold new program offered by The Foundation from our Los Angeles office to promote and protect the Spanish Horse that is so dear to us.

If you wish to have your horse in the Spanish Stud Book

Your horse is eligible to participate in this program with the LG if the horse is registered with the P.R.E. Mundial Registry as of December 31, 2018 *and* the horse meets one of the following criteria:

1. Both parents of your horse are already in the LG;
2. One of the parents of your horse is already in the LG and the other parent is alive and holds a Carta Mundial. The parent holding a Carta Mundial must then be inscribed and revised by the LG.
3. If neither parent is in the LG, both parents must be alive and must go through the inscription and revision process by the LG. Then the offspring of these parents will be eligible for registration in the LG after they pass their own revisions.
4. If your horse is a gelding, you can inscribe but not revise your horse.

However, your horse *cannot participate* in this program if:

1. The horse has already failed two revisions with the LG inspectors;

2. If one of the horse's parents has failed two revisions with the LG inspectors; or,
3. If either parent is dead and was not revised by the LG before death.

This program, offered for a limited time only, will be managed directly through The Foundation at a discounted price of \$200 for each inscription, and \$120 for each revision. You do not need to present any new paperwork. During the inspections, both registration and the reproductive evaluation can be done at the same time which will speed up the process.

In order to set up convenient sites for the inspection and approval of your horses, please call 818-874-1489 by September 13, 2019, to let us know that you want to participate. We will attempt to have the delegate brought as close to your location as possible. If you can host a site for inspection, please also let us know when you call.

If you have sold a horse and don't know if it has been transferred into the new owner's name, please contact the new owner with this information.

If you do not want to participate, or if your horses do not qualify for participation, and you want your horses registered with a working registry, please contact the long-standing US registry, the International Andalusian and Lusitano Horse Association at www.ialha.org.

As we move forward, The Foundation will focus on other programs that will better reflect our mission to promote and protect this remarkable breed.
