In 1988, **Miguel Anacoreta** joined the Escola Portuguesa de Arte Equestre at the age of 15 and remained with the school for 13 years. During that time he was trained daily by the esteemed director of the school, the late **Dr. Guilherme Borba**, who himself was trained by **Master Nuno Oliviera** and in Vienna at the **Spanish Riding School**. During his time with the school, Miguel participated in numerous exhibitions all over Europe, and was one of the select riders to train and perform the airs above the ground. *The Portuguese school is a sister school to the Spanish Riding School and is one of the four great equestrian schools of Europe.* Miguel's training methods are in keeping with that classical tradition.

**Miguel** also has extensive experience with the competitive side of dressage – he is an international competitor in *Doma Clasica* (showing both Iberians and other breeds) and his Lusitano, *Vinegra*, was pre-selected for the Portuguese Olympic team. Miguel is also **EXPERT** at in-hand training.
